Contacting your Local Employment and Independence for People with Disabilities (EIPD) Office



Check the <u>EIPD Website</u> for phone numbers and emails for the local offices.

If you call and they are not available, leave them a voicemail.

- Make sure that your voicemail box is set up and has space for new messages. And when you check your email, also check your spam folder.
- If you have contact information for specific staff, you can also use those.
- If you have contacted EIPD previously, check your voicemail, email, and paper mail, before contacting them again.



After 5 business days, if your local EIPD office has not reached out to you, try reaching out again. Find & call your regional office:
