Work Together NC

Work Together NC is a statewide initiative that supports individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD). Launched in 2021, WTNC is funded through a federal Project of National Significance grant from the Administration for Community Living. The grant was awarded to the TEACCH Autism Program within the Department of Psychiatry at the UNC School of Medicine. Dr. Brianne Tomaszewski serves as the Principal Investigator.

North Carolina is one of seven sites selected to design and test strategies that improve outcomes for transition-aged youth with I/DD.

WTNC's goals are to:

- Make systems of support easier to navigate during and after the transition to adulthood.
- Increase access to meaningful employment, continuing education, and community participation after high school.

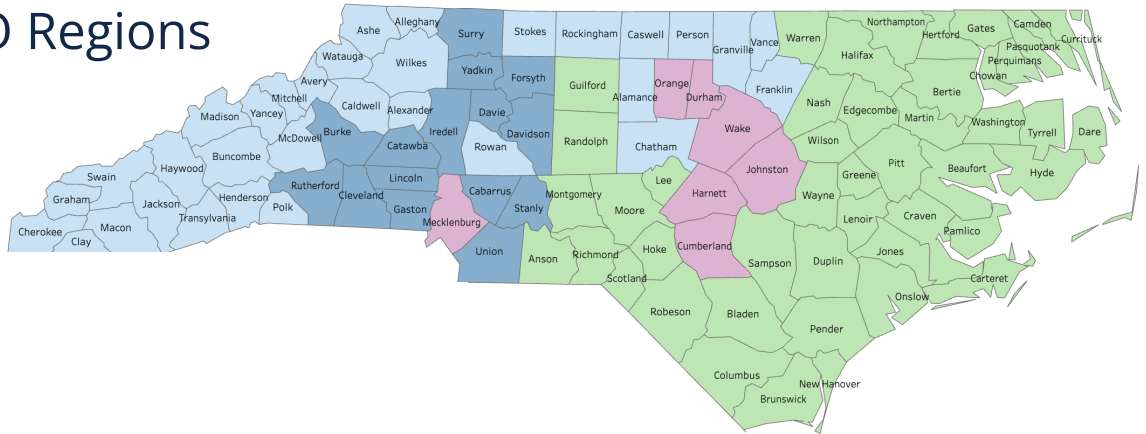

- Service Library by Physical Location: Students can explore hands on services and groups located in their area.

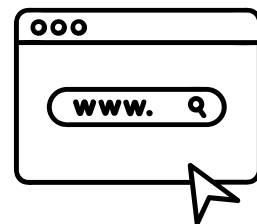
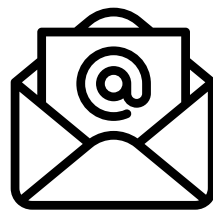
