"What do you like doing now, Ash?" my teacher asked.







I thought about it for a minute and said, "I like caring for animals and being creative. Maybe I could work at an animal shelter, or do something with art."




Everyone nodded, and it made me feel awesome to know I had a say in my future.




One of my goals is to get a job one day, so I'm going to start building my skills through volunteering.




