## And need a lot of support, now and in the future

For instance, your loved one may need help with tasks like bathing, eating, cooking or working. (In technical terms, this is called meeting ICF-IID level of care, which means they have needs similar to people placed in an intermediate care facility. You do not need to know this to apply.)



## Secure your spot.

Get on the NC Innovations waiver waitlist.

We encourage you to apply as soon as you have a diagnosis, especially if services may be needed in the future.

People who have extraordinary circumstances or emergencies may be eligible to skip the waitlist.



1 First, call 1-855-262-1946 to find your county's organization.

Ask: "I am in [county]. Who do I call to apply for the NC Innovations waiver?"

2 Next, call your county's organization to apply.

Say: ("I want to apply for the NC Innovations waiver."

They will guide you through the process.

Also ask: "What services can I get while I am on the waitlist?"

They can tell you which services may be available to you. For example, if you have NC Medicaid, you may be eligible for support at home through "1915(i) services."
